 - Need to keep ramps clear; direct crowd towards bleachers
 - Clocks to be added to Tavern & Lounge for judges
 - Removal of more glass for coaches to have easier access to skaters
 - Two (2) entry doors onto each rink for compulsory events.
 - Assign judges to rinks
 - Basic Skills = smaller groups of skaters competing
 - Basic Skills = Five (5) judges for these events
